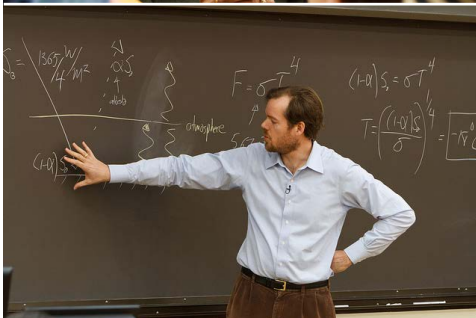

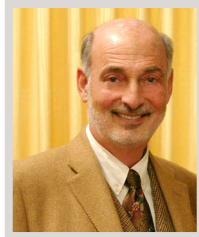
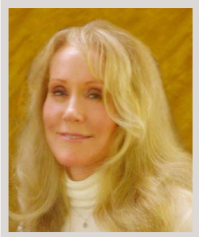

women so that companies can promote a variety of business goals.

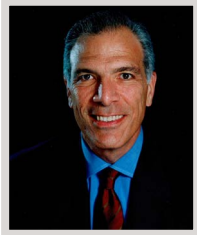

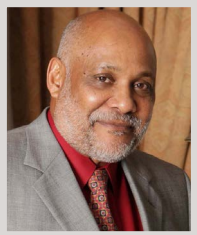

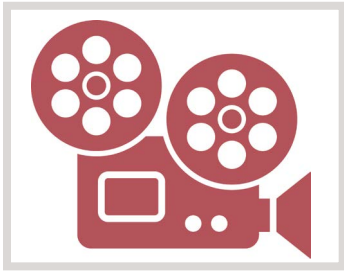

Professor Koh was recently featured in the Harvard School of Public Health news article "Measles outbreaks worrying, but 'on-time' childhood vaccination remains norm in U.S." Despite recent news stories of measles outbreaks in the U.S., a working group charged by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) looked into national vaccine confidence and found that the overwhelming majority of parents are vaccinating their children. To those who aren't, Professor Koh stresses the importance of working with parents to build their trust in vaccines.

Message from the Chair

From February 26 - 27, the Advanced Leadership Initiative held an Environment Think Tank for current AL Fellows. Advanced Leadership Initiative Executive Board Member and HBS Professor Forest Reinhardt, alongside HBS Professor Rebecca Henderson, convened several leaders of thought and practice in environmental research and reform to serve as Think Tank speakers. Over the course of two days, participants engaged in a rich exploration of key themes pertaining to how business should address climate change. Some key topics discussed included:

- the costs of emissions reductions
- the uncertainty about our estimates of these costs
- How concern about climate change affects the optimal portfolio of energy sources, roles firms can play in reducing their own emissions, in reducing the environmental impacts of their supply chains, and in improving the environmental performance of their customers
- How these actions be made profitable
- Business opportunities created by climate change
- Firms and trade associations roles in political and regulatory processes both domestically and internationally.
- How business leaders should approach their responsibilities in this arena

Videos and a post-Think Tank report will be available soon, outlining the key themes and learnings from the two days.

We look forward to seeing AL Fellows, past and present, at our upcoming Health Care and Education Think Tanks.
